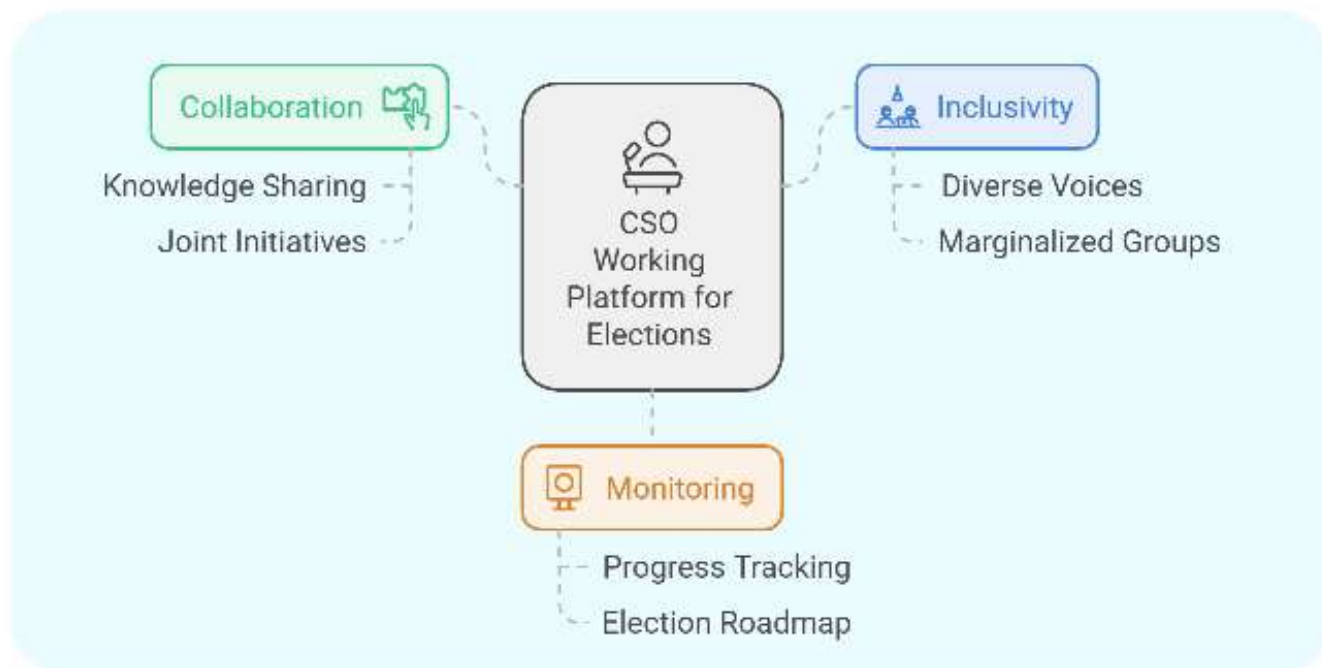


Establishment of a CSO Working Platform on the Roadmap to the Next Elections

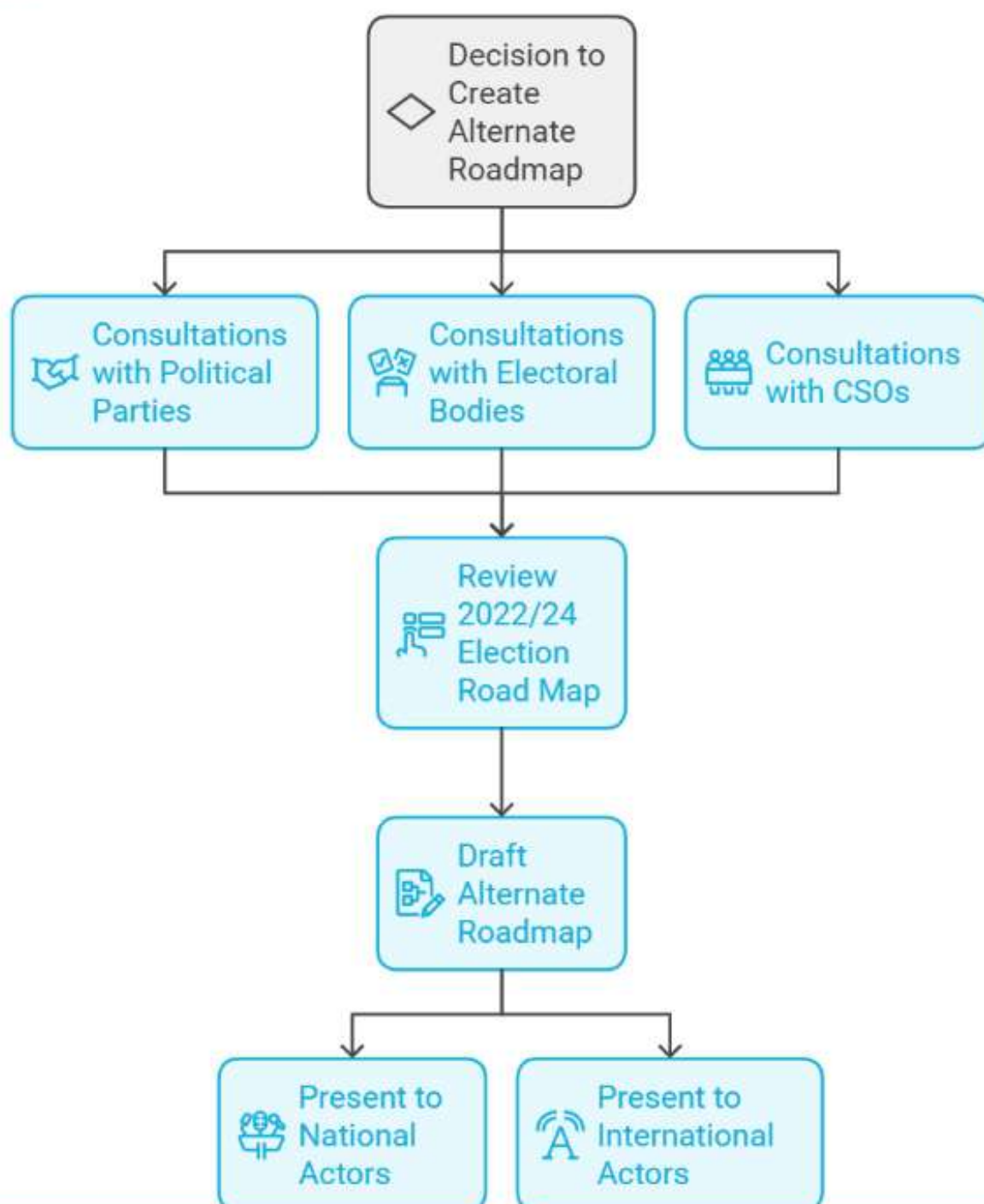

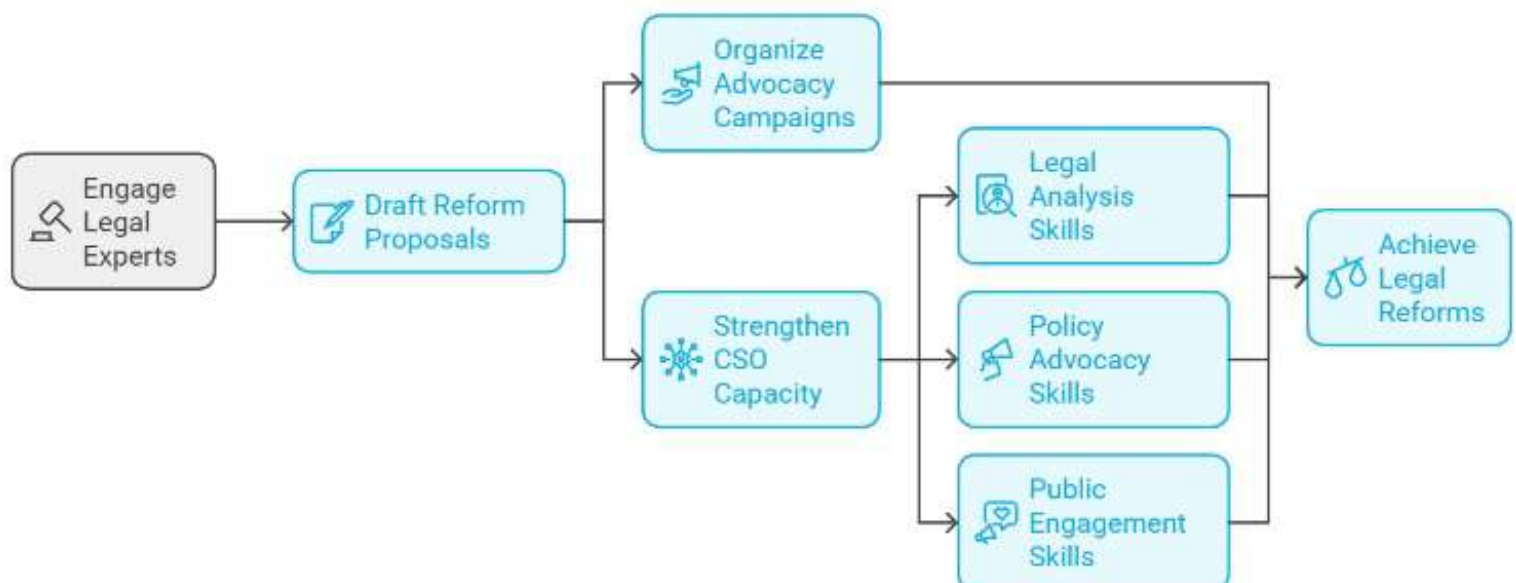
Setting the Agenda for Minimal Reforms Needed for the Next Elections

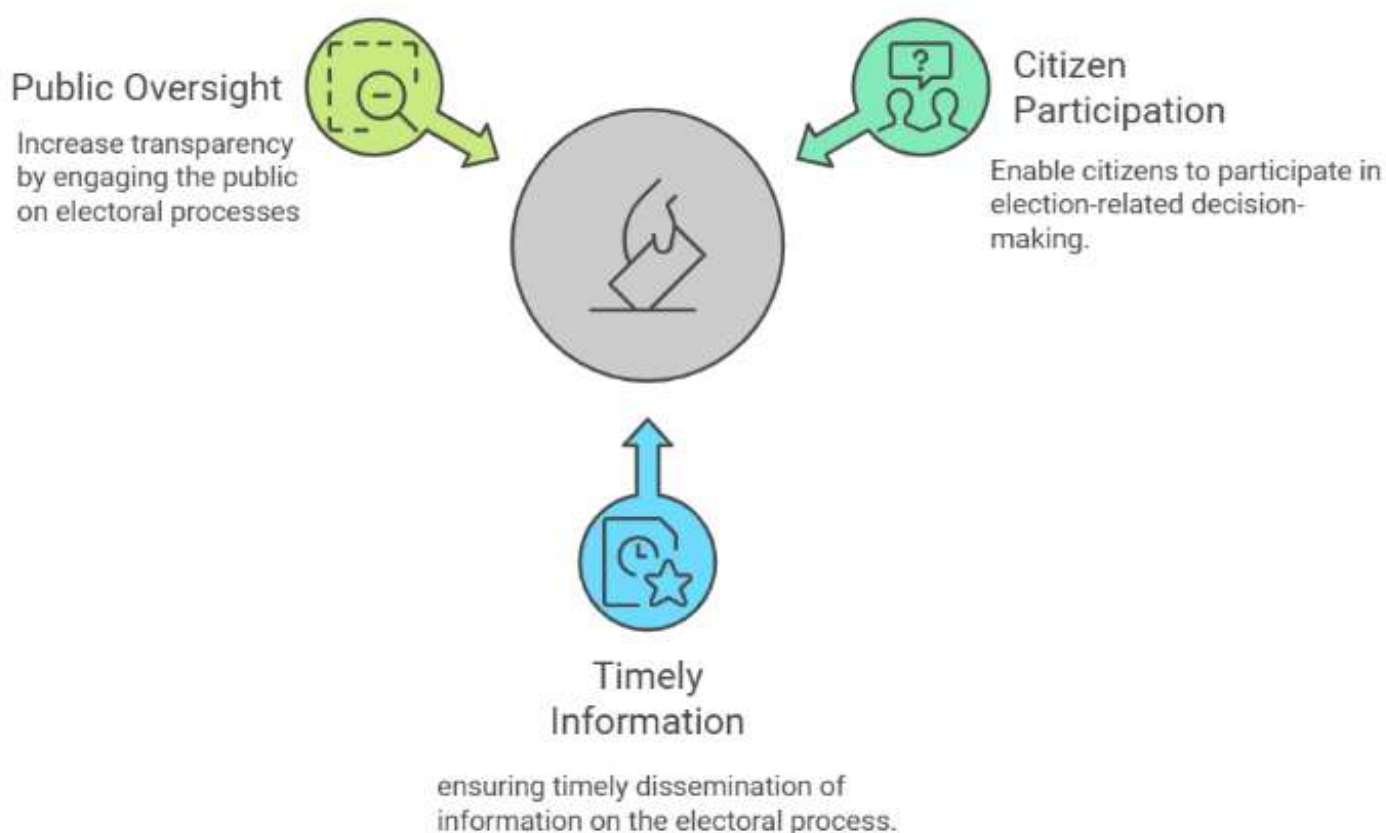

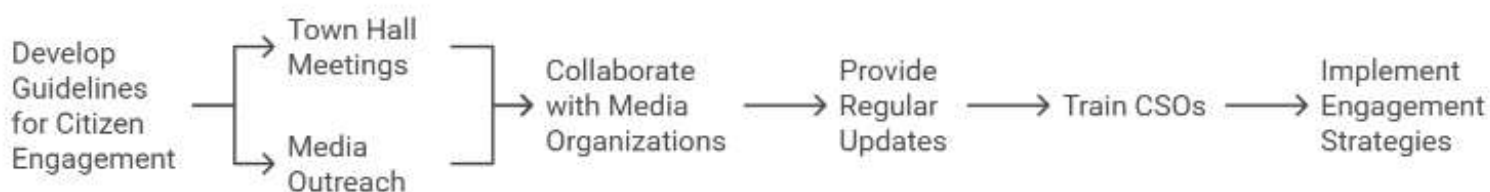

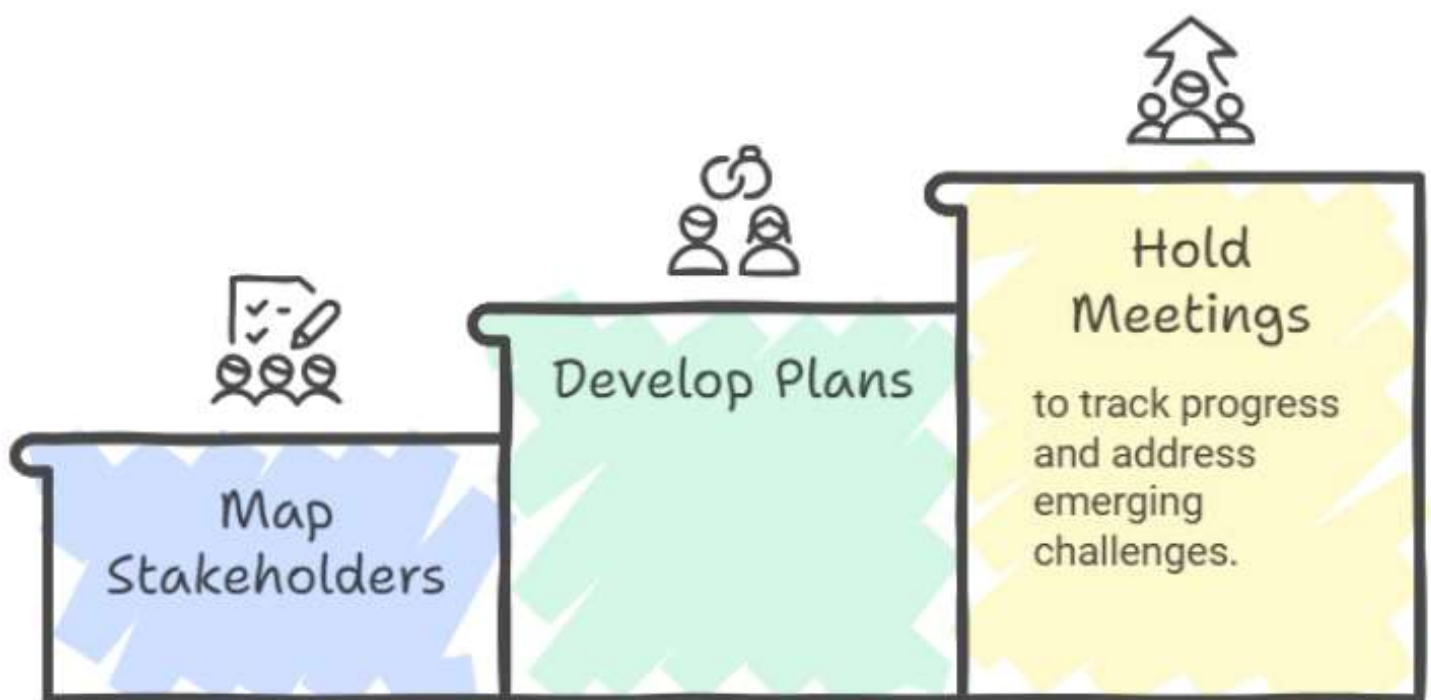


Strategy for Targeted Stakeholder Engagement with Duty Bearers and Strategic Actors
